Monitoring of Attendance

6. **QR Codes**. Delegates will be issued their individual QR codes at the opening of the Congress.
7. **Certificates of Attendance**. For the issuance of Certificates of Attendance, delegates must have their QR codes scanned at the following times on both Days 1 and 2:
 - upon entering the morning plenary session;
 - upon entering the afternoon plenary session; and,
 - upon leaving the closing session at the end of each Day.

MCLE

8. **MCLE units**. Delegates may earn up to 7.5 units by attending an aggregate of 7.5 hours of plenary or breakout sessions at the Congress. A minimum attendance of 2 hours is required for units to be credited.
9. **MCLE Registration and Fee**. After securing your QR codes, please proceed to separately register at the MCLE counter. A fee of P100 will be required.
10. **Monitoring of attendance**. In addition to their QR codes being scanned for the issuance of Certificates of Attendance, MCLE registrants should have their QR codes **additionally** scanned by MCLE monitors at the following times:
 - Upon **entering and leaving all** plenary sessions;
 - Upon **entering and leaving all** breakout sessions.

12. **Face mask**. Please wear face masks at all times during the Congress.
