Amazing Results



Seminar 2.6 on “Global History and the Construction of Global Citizenship”, which took place at UP (16th May) and at USA (18 to 20 and 23 to 26th May) was a success.

Seminar 2.1 on Knowledge Sharing and the Modernization of Criminal Law, which took place at The Judicial Academy Philippines from 6 to 9 June was attended by approximately 188 people and its audience included key stakeholders for the objectives of CALESA, such as members of the Judiciary, members from Legal Academy, representatives of Government agencies and non-government offices. The Sixth Spanish-Filipino Scientific Congress: Modernizing Criminal Law and Private Law Euro Asia Vision 2022 took place on 9 and 10th June 2022 at UP and gathered **more than 80 speakers** to discuss the modernization of criminal and private law, whilst contributing to the enhancement of research capacity of Philippine law schools and addressing other concerns in scholarly advancement.
