



CALL FOR PAPERS

The University of Malaga is organizing the *INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CONVENTION ON PHILIPPINE LITERATURE IN SPANISH* from 2 to 3 November 2023 in Malaga (Spain), which aims to highlight the value of Philippine literature written in Spanish and to emphasize its connection with the Spanish-speaking community and its relevance in the Asian context.

As a way of stimulating the participation of Professors and Researchers from different institutions and amplify the debate and discussion around the topic among different academic communities, a call for papers is now open.

1. PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS / RULES

1.1 Each participant may only submit one paper for examination.

1.2 Papers should be submitted via email to the address:

1.3 Papers should be novel and should not have been published before.

1.4 Papers should have a scientific nature.

1.5 Papers will be admitted in English and Spanish.

2. FORMAT INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Papers should only be submitted in doc. or docx. Formats

2.2 Papers should have between 10 – 15 pages.

2.3 Papers should contain:

- a) Title of the paper;
- b) Name of the author;



- c) Academic qualification as a footnote after the name of the author (include only higher academic qualification, institution to which the author is linked to and email.)
- d) Abstract
- e) Chapters (Development of the paper)
- f) Closing Remarks
- g) References

2.4 The thematic area under which papers are developed should be linked to the title of the International Convention and/or to the thematic axes mentioned in the infosheet published in the CALESA website.

3. ASSESSMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Submitted papers will be assessed by the Coordination of the CALESA project.
- 3.2 The rules from item 2 will be used as parameters for selection of the best papers.
- 3.3 The coordination will also take into account the following aspects of the papers during the evaluation process: originality, relevance of the theme and its pertinence to the event, objective of the paper, research question, contextualization of the research problem, theoretical framework for the research, methodological clarity; coherence and cohesion of the text; pertinence of the conclusions.

4. PUBLICATION

- 4.1 All selected papers will be presented during the International Convention, which will take place at the Universidad de Málaga, in Málaga, Spain.
- 4.2 The costs for the author's participation, including possible registration fees and travel expenses, will be covered by the author.
- 4.3 The oral presentations of the selected papers will last 10 minutes.
- 4.4 As they submit papers to the event, authors give away authorship rights over the paper, so that they may be considered as outputs the referred project.
- 4.5 All articles will be published in the CALESA webpage.
